We are entering the final stages of listening as part of the Our Church's Future Story project to develop a plan for the life and work of the church over the next few years.

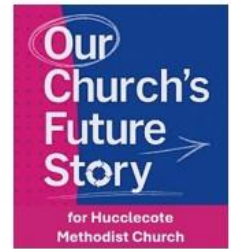

The project steering group will collect all the answers together and then there will be some meetings to discuss where we go from here.

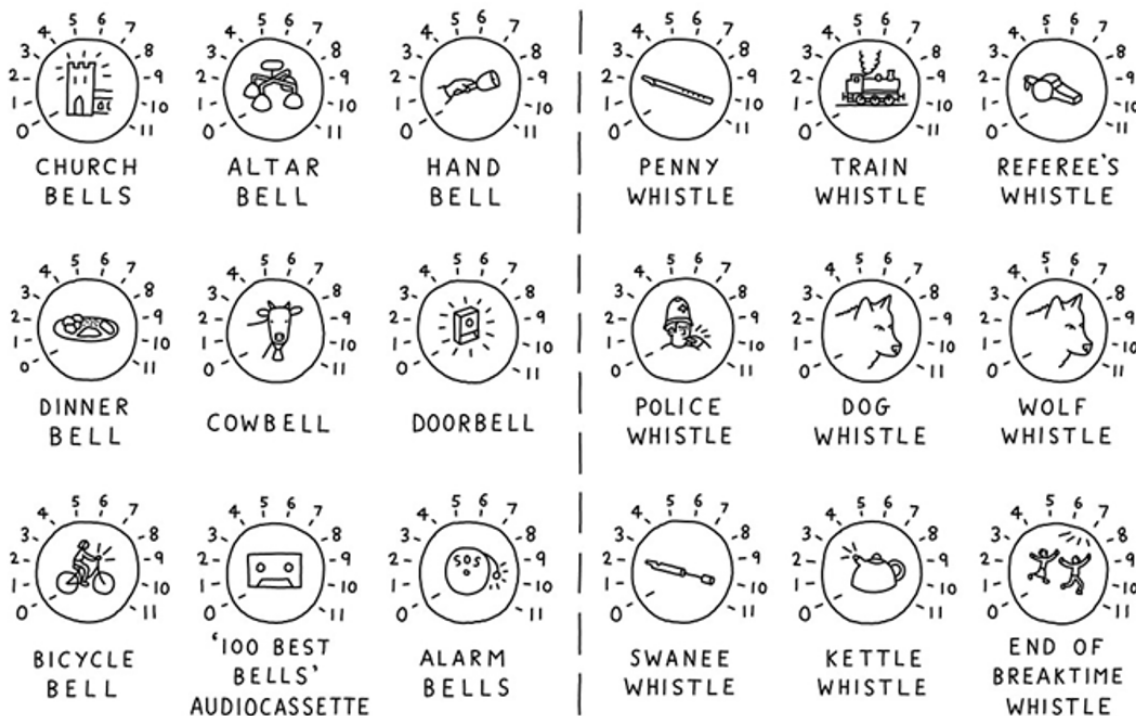
